Plácido Domingo, one of the original "Three Tenors," joins the "dream couple" of the operatic world, Anna Netrebko and Rolando Villazón, in an open-air concert recorded in front of a live audience of 20,000 spectators and broadcast to millions around the world. Accompanied by the orchestra of the Deutsche Oper Berlin under Marco Armiliato, they sing some of the most beloved arias, songs and ensembles of all time, from Verdi to Puccini and from Bizet to Bernstein. Rarely have three such high-caliber artists come together in one concert. Domingo: the epitome of the operatic tenor, still a master of suave lyricism after a career of 45 years. Netrebko: the fiery Russian beauty who unleashed a worldwide media frenzy in 2005 as a sexy and sensual Violetta in "La Traviata" and has embarked on a phenomenal international career. Villazón: the tall, dark and handsome Mexican with the heartrendingly expressive voice, who was discovered and mentored by Domingo himself. The concert was recorded on 7 July 2006 at Berlin's legendary Waldbühne, an amphitheater-inspired outdoor venue in a lush natural setting. "Three Superstars in Berlin" – a summit meeting of extraordinary artists, a stimulating get-together of three friends.
